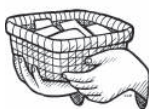

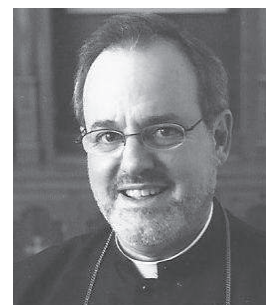

BEING FAITHFUL TO CHRIST IN THE CULTURE WAR

Girls as Prom Kings? Boys and Girls Using Opposite Sex Bathrooms & Showers?

Recently we have seen our local Kenosha Unified School District officials shamefully overrule the Tremper High School principal and allow a girl who “identifies herself as a boy” to run for prom king. This girl wants to use the boy’s bathrooms as well. In his recent letter on the family, “The Joy of Love,” Pope Francis speaks of the “*challenge posed by the various forms of an ideology of gender that denies the difference and reciprocity in nature of a man and a woman and envisages a society without sexual differences, thereby eliminating the anthropological basis of the family. This ideology leads to educational programs and legislative enactments that promote a personal identity and emotional intimacy radically separated from the biological difference between male and female. Consequently, human identity becomes the choice of the individual, one which can also change over time.*”

***Fr. Campbell comments: Sadly, the world is going mad, losing touch with reality. There is no such thing as a “transgendered person.” As Genesis reveals, God “made them *male and female.*” We must stand up for the truth in the public square if we are to be counted among Christ's flock when He comes again.**

Shame on Notre Dame for Honoring Pro-Abort Joe Biden!

(LifeSite News April 7, 2016) Raymond Cardinal Burke, in a recent interview, rebuked the University of Notre Dame for honoring Vice-President Joseph Biden – who calls himself a Catholic yet supports the legalized murder of unborn children through abortion and same-sex “marriage” – with its highest award. “I find it difficult to imagine that a Catholic university would assign its highest honor to any politician who favors abortion and who also advocates for the recognition of the sexual liaison of two people of the same sex as equal to marriage,” said the cardinal. “It is even more difficult to imagine that the university would confer such an honor upon a Roman Catholic who supports these anti-life and anti-family policies and legislation.”

Mississippi’s governor faces down the corporate bullies and leftist pressure groups

April 7, 2016 ([DailySignal](#)) -- On Tuesday, Gov. Phil Bryant of Mississippi signed the Protecting Freedom of Conscience from Government Discrimination Act into law. To protect religious liberty in his state, he stood up against corporate bullies and leftist pressure groups.

In the last few years, states and localities nationwide have prosecuted small businesses for declining involvement in gay marriage ceremonies. We’ve seen the government do some pretty terrible things, like Washington state trying to bankrupt a 70-year-old florist, or Oregon fining a bakery \$135,000. We’ve even seen the most intolerant tendencies of the Left’s rank-and-file when a pizza place in Indiana was threatened with violence for even discussing the possibility of not participating in a gay wedding celebration.

The message has been clear: *It’s not enough to respect everyone, to live and let live. You must actively participate in ceremonies that go against your beliefs or the government will punish you.*

To make matters worse, whenever state legislatures have considered religious freedom bills to protect regular Americans from this intolerance, activist groups and massive corporations like Disney, Hilton and Marriott have shown up and threatened boycotts, protests, and relocations. Recently, lawmakers in West Virginia and Georgia have been cowed into shelving or vetoing these common sense policies [by big corporations, including the National Football League!]

This is the toxic atmosphere of corporate bullying Bryant chose to fight. As he wrote in a signing statement: “*I am signing HB 1523 into law to protect sincerely held religious beliefs and moral convictions of individuals, organizations and private associations from discriminatory action by state government or its political subdivisions [...] This bill merely reinforces the rights which currently exist to the exercise of religious freedom as stated in the First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution.*”

A shocking amount of slanted news stories uncritically describe Mississippi’s new law as “anti-gay” or “discriminatory.” Nothing could be further from the truth. The law now simply protects *religious organizations* and a narrow slice of small businesses from being forced by government to engage in behavior that contradicts their deeply held beliefs. Nobody is being denied services because of who they are.

***Fr. Campbell comments: We should *boycott* Disney, Hilton – AND THE NFL! – for not only embracing the sodomite agenda, but for trying to force us – as individuals and as members of religious organizations – to violate our consciences!**

LGBTQ activists tell Hollywood:

‘Our strategy is you:

The entertainment industry’

LOS ANGELES, April 5, 2016 ([LifeSiteNews](#)) -- The 27th Annual Gay & Lesbian Alliance Against Defamation (GLAAD) Media Awards took place at the Beverly Hilton Hotel in Los Angeles on Saturday. At the awards ceremony, gay activists admitted that their strategy to influence the American people toward acceptance of homosexuality was through the media of television, movies, and mainstream news.

GLAAD president and CEO Sarah Kate Ellis said, "With over 100 anti-LGBT bills in state and local levels [like bathroom privacy bills in N. Carolina and other states], our strategy is you: The entertainment industry." The national leader admitted that to gain the approval of average Americans, over a number of years gay activists manipulated the media to change popular views of sodomy and lesbianism. "Through media and story telling, we build awareness, galvanize action and accelerate acceptance," Sarah Kate Ellis said.

"This is hardly surprising," commented Dan Gainor, Vice President for Business and Culture at the [Media Research Center](#). "Hollywood has been pushing the gay agenda since the 1970s." "Even Vice President Joe Biden [noticed](#), saying: 'I think Will & Grace probably did more to educate the American public than almost anything anybody's ever done so far.'"

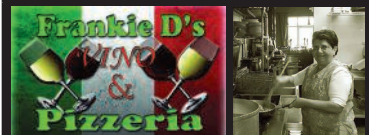
